These guidelines have been prepared to ensure effectively organizing cluster level awareness program for Bamboo Farmers/ Forest owners/artisans of MegLIFE Villages to develop Bamboo based Income Generation clusters in MegLIFE villages. The documents includes program guidelines and deadlines for submission of gatherted in formation. Format for data collection has been shared in Google sheet with all concerned.

Guidelines for activities relating bamboo to be undertaken in MegLIFE villages in convergence with Meghalaya State Bamboo Mission

It has been seen that there exists immense opportunity for developing bamboo-based income generation activities in MegLIFE Project, MBDA by integration with the Meghalaya State Bamboo Mission scheme (MSBM). Integrating MSBM's activities is a huge opportunity, the benefits of which shall also reach out to the VPIC members of MegLIFE villages.

In this context, a Training of Trainers (ToT) program was organized involving DPMs, BPMs and IGA staff of the MegLIFE project on bamboo resource survey, bamboo propagation, plantation including nursery, maintenance of the bamboo forests, scientific harvesting of bamboo and bamboo-based income generation activities. The objective of the ToT is to develop Master Trainers who will in turn organize similar cluster level awareness programs on bamboo involving VPIC members.

Following is the roadmap for convergence with the Meghalaya State Bamboo Mission Scheme with MegLIFE Project-

1. Cluster-level Awareness Generation programs by the trained Master Trainers (MT) in the MegLIFE villages. Deadline for completion of the assignment is Feb, 2025 for Garo Region and March, 25 for Khasi & Jaintia Region.

The following would be the details of the proposed awareness generation program: -

Participants:-

- Bamboo Forest owners/community leaders of the MegLIFE Villages of the cluster (community land/Clan land/private land)
- Traditional bamboo artisans

Points to be discussed-

- How much area of bamboo forest exists under their ownership
- Which species of bamboo (collect local names and make list with scientific names)
- Usage pattern (Selling or using for self-consumption)
- Purpose
- If selling bamboo, then where and at what price and the end utility
- Opportunity to take up bamboo ANR plantations in the moderately dense forests (Unit cost per ha cost is Rs.1 lakh for 3 years)
- Discuss on the possibilities on augmentation of bamboo resources through plantations for supply to the industries and on raising bamboo saplings in decentralized community nurseries.
- Training on establishment bamboo nursery
- Training on sustainable management of bamboo forests for improving quality and quantity of bamboos for fetching better price.
- Willingness of the VPIC members for raising community nurseries for profit as an IGA (requirement of land for small nursery is 0.5 ha and cost is Rs.10 lakhs per nursery)
- Information on Bamboo-based income generation activities such as:
 - a) Aggregation and sale of bamboos in Common Facility Centres (CFCs) in order to get better prices by removing middlemen between the bamboo forest owners and the traders.
 - b) Opportunity for getting more value per bamboo through primary processing like cutting/ splitting/knot removing/slat preparation by using machines at CFCs rather than selling raw bamboo poles.
 - c) Opportunities on skill development trainings and use of machines on manufacturing involving traditional artisans for making high value products
 - d) Facility for market linkages

• For villages having IVCS centres where 3rd phase of community hall is completed discuss about keeping the machineries for primary processing for temporary basis. If space is not available for construction of CFC in the community hall premises, then selection of site for CFC construction (site shall be within the habitation of the village and shall have electric pole nearby along with water availability)

For organization of the awareness programs SPMU will issue sanctions as per model budget (annexed at **Annexure-1**) and as per number of clusters per DPMU. DPMU shall submit UCs after completion of the awareness programs to SPMU. (deadline 20th March,2025)

- 2. Submission of district-wise compiled data collected on bamboo resource availability to SPMU (deadline Feb,25 for Garo Region and March,25 for Khasi & Jaintia Region) (Format attached at **Annexure-2**)
- 3. Completion of feasibility for construction of CFC in the premises of the existing community halls. (deadline Feb,25 for Garo Region and March,25 for Khasi & Jaintia Region)
- 4. If not feasible, then selection of site for CFC construction. (deadline Feb,25 for Garo Region and March,25 for Khasi & Jaintia Region)

Depending on the information received from the DPMUs, an action plan for FY 2025-26 on activities to be undertaken, in convergence with the MSBM scheme in MegLIFE villages will be prepared and submitted to the MSBM.
